Caves Henri de Richemer, Sauvignon Blanc

Thirst-quenching citrus fruit, soft acidity and a lovely floral spiciness characterize this crisp, dry wine from the Loire Valley.

The Saar rises in the Vosges and gradually joins the Moselle. The wines of Van Volxem belong to the best of this wine region and are distinguished by their steely minerality, lively acidity and purity.

Bairrada Tinto, Vadio

Gourmet wine that combines Atlantic style with power. The Baga grape is perhaps a bit the Nebbiolo of Portugal: beautiful with floral and earthy scents, and on the palate fresh acidity and ripe fruit that bitterly counteract the traditional tannins

This Chianti tastes almost like a classic Bordeaux. With a light earthy tone, a slender structure, fine-meshed tannins and subtle black cherry fruit in the scent.

Rosé

Côteaux Varois en Provence, L'Oratoire Saint Andrieu

Pale pink rosé from Provence with tasty roundness by adding a handful of vermentina grapes. Characteristic and fashionable at the same time with white flowers in the nose and fresh berries and garrigue in the grenache-dominated taste.

A 100% Ecological Cava of the classic Cava grapes: Xarel·lo and Parellada. Faultless, elegant and refreshing.
